Membership Rules

1. All members are required to have a credit card on file.
2. House Account Statements will be produced monthly. You may at anytime during the month check your charges or balance in the Pro Shop.

House Account Payment Options

1. The Pro Shop will process your credit card on the last day of the month for the outstanding balance. (most convenient option) Or.....
2. The Pro Shop will produce your monthly statement for pick up on the first day of the next month.

Superintendent's Shack By Jason Bailey Practice Putting Green Renovation

In August we decided to test a couple of new grasses on the market for a potential redo of our front nine greens next year. We redid our existing Tifdwarf bermuda-grass putting green by spraying out the old grass and laying the new grasses right on top.

A little sand, water, and fertilizer was all that was needed to produce the superb putting surface 8 weeks later.



The new grasses we used are the top two bermuda-grass 'ultradwarf' varieties on the market, Tifeagle and Miniverde. These grasses are called ultra-dwarf because of their ability to withstand very low mowing heights and still look and play great.

We are currently mowing the PG 20% lower than the other greens with still the ability to take the height down another 15% without damage. All this equates to true, smooth rolls on faster greens and hopefully better scores. We divided the PG into two halves, north and south, with each side having one of the grasses.
