newly chosen grass for Provo Golf Club's greens due to its exceptional putting surface and disease tolerant features. Tif Eagle has been around for many years and is highly regarded throughout the industry which has made it the choice at many championship courses around the world.



The prepared green receives the boxed sprigs: 5 weeks after the process began

As of July 16th we took our first step in the greens renovation process by spraying out the old greens on the front nine. The greens slowly turned brown and fast just like the last day of a US Open. Over the following five weeks there will be other applications and procedures to prepare the greens for the transition. Our target date for the new Tif Eagle sprigging is Monday, August 20th. When all goes well the new sprigs should start to "tack" in after a week; leading to brand new greens only eight weeks later. In between there will be lots of irrigating, top dressing, fertilizing, and even an aerification to prepare the new grass surface. Monitoring will be done a couple times each day on every green to ensure that no problems arise through insects, disease, weeds, and most importantly wilt.

As we continue to improve the condition of the Provo Golf Club we have great confidence in the fact that you will enjoy the new Tif Eagle greens.
